This Licence is issued in accordance with the following conditions:

- This licence only permits capture-darting followed by lethal injection or captive bolt pistol, under veterinary supervision as the means of euthanasia for independent kangaroos. Pouch young are to be euthanased as per the Code of Practice for the Humane Destruction of Kangaroos in the ACT
- All shooters involved in the capture-darting activities under this licence are to have had previous experience under veterinary supervision in capture-darting of animals.
- The following records are to be maintained continually throughout the operation (a) the number of male kangaroos killed other than pouch young (b) the number of female kangaroos killed other than pouch young (c) the number of pouch young killed (d) the number of adult male kangaroos released alive (e) the number of adult female kangaroos released alive (f) the number of pouch young released alive (g) the number of male kangaroos injured (h) the number of female kangaroos injured
- Injured here is not meant to include the use of capture-darts in normal use but means injuries which are inadvertent, such as resulting from collisions and which are so serious as to lead to the death of the kangaroo. Fatal overheating, dehydration or drowning is to be reported as injury.
- All activities under this licence are to be in accordance with the provisions detailed in the Code of Practice for the Humane Destruction of Kangaroos in the ACT.

- 8 This licence is not transferable
- 9 The Licensee will provide the Conservator of Flora and Fauna a report by the way of a return at the conclusion of the activity under this licence. This return will detail the EGK killed, and the actual dates of any activity undertaken pursuant to this licence. The culling return, together with unused tags must be returned to the PCL Rural Programs staff within one month of the end of each culling period.
- 10 It is a condition of this licence that subsequent licence applications can not be processed until a cull return for each cull period has been provided to PCL Rural Programs Staff. (Rural Programs Officer, Stromlo Depot GPO Box 158 Canberra City ACT 2601).
- 11 The Conservator of Flora and Fauna may require a Conservation Officer to be present and to observe any activity undertaken under this licence
- 12 Animals taken under this licence must not be left lying within 100m of any boundary.
- 13 The Licensee must ensure that carcasses are not left within public view and should not be piled at a central location or let lie within a water course.
- 14 Culling may be undertaken at night by spotlight, or within daylight hours
- 15 Shooting activities to be conducted with respect to public safety eg: residential housing and main roads.
