I refer to your request, made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act), for documents relating to loose-fill asbestos, specifically a report on asbestos contamination at 25 Bradfield Street, Downer and to documents and correspondence related to this report.

I am authorised, under section 22 of the Act, to make decisions on access to documents and liability for charges.

In terms of the identification and consideration of documents relevant to your request, I have interpreted the scope to specifically refer to the report on asbestos contamination at 25 Bradfield Street, Downer, ACT.

#### **Charges**

I have decided, under section 29 of the Act, not to impose processing charges for this request.

#### **Identification of Documents**

Thorough searches of paper and electronic files and email accounts have been conducted. The documents that are relevant to your request are managed by the Office of Industrial Relations.

#### **Decision on access**

As indicated in my letter to you of 14 March 2014, under section 27 of the Act, I have undertaken consultation with third parties on the information containing their business affairs to allow them a reasonable opportunity to contend that this information be publicly released. There has been no objection of release.

I have decided to provide to you, in full, the *Asbestos Remediation Final Report on 25 Bradfield Street, Downer ACT 2602* that Robson Environmental prepared for the Community Services Directorate in November 2013; a copy of this report is enclosed.

## Your right of review

### *Internal Review*

Under section 59 (1) of the Act, you may request a review of my decision. You have 28 days after receiving notice of my decision to ask for a review, or a further period as allowed by the Director-General. Your request should be addressed to:


