I refer to your request under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* dated 4 February 2015 in which you requested the following documents:

Communication (including attachments and other documents related to such communication) between: (a) Ms Burch and/or her staff; and (b) ClubsACT and/or its representatives. Of this communication, I seek only those documents that are relevant to the tabling of the Gaming Machine Amendment regulation 2014 (No 2) – i.e. the decision to amend the Gaming Machine Regulation 2004 so as to remove the offence in relation to gaming machines that accept \$50 notes.

I am an authorised decision maker for access to the documents you are seeking.

I have included a schedule of the documents identified in relation to your request together with a copy of all documents which I have decided to release in keeping with the FOI Act.

A total of 4 groups of documents were considered to fall within the scope of your request, and are attached.
