19/767 Review of the operation of mental health orders under the ACT Mental Health Act 2015.

Summary of impacts:

- The report finds that psychiatric treatment orders and community care orders are operating as intended.
- The report finds that forensic mental health orders and forensic community care orders are not operating as intended due to the adverse consequences on victims' access to information when an order is not made.
