Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 13 April 2023. As agreed by you on 5 April 2023, in accordance with section 41 of the Act, an additional 15 working days has been added to the processing time extending the decision due date to 5 May 2023.

Decision on access

Searches were completed for relevant information and documents were identified that fall within the scope of your request.

Section 43(1)(d) of the Act states a respondent may refuse to deal with an access application if:

- *the government information is already available to the applicant (see section 45)*

Section 45 (g) of the Act states that for section 43(1)(d), government information is already available to the applicant only if the information:

- *is usually available for purchase.*

Therefore, I have decided to refuse to deal with your application because the information you are seeking is publicly available for a fee.

Charges


