FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), transferred from Transport Canberra and City Services to the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 24 August 2023, in which you sought access to:

Parking infringement officers' hazard reporting policy

Please note, this is part of a larger access application the majority of which is being dealt with by Transport Canberra and City Services.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of CMTEDD under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes
