Summary of impacts:

- ACT Government prepared a response to the Report by the Standing Committee on Economic Development and Tourism Inquiry into Drone Delivery Systems in the ACT. The inquiry seeks to determine the appropriate scope and breadth of future noise regulation in relation to Remote Piloted Aircraft, such as drone operations and urban air mobility aircraft.
- The response addresses the ACT Government's regulatory view of drone regulation and noise experiences with the Wing drone delivery trial.
