I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (FOI Act), section 14, received by the Community Services Directorate on 14 September 2017, in which you requested the following documents:

*I would like access to: "a previous FOI request from 2014 was for "Stock by Suburb" of public housing stock. It was processed on 4 July 2014... reference 14-125. I request the information from that FOI release to be updated to the most current data please"*

Under the FOI Act, section 22, I am an officer authorised to make a decision in respect of a request for information.

### Decision

Please find attached a copy of the report on Stock by Suburb for the period 30 June 2014 – 30 June 2017. As the report does not contain information that may be prevented from release under the provisions of the FOI ACT, it is my decision to release this to you in full.

I note in your email correspondence of 14 September 2017, you were unable to locate a copy of the FOI reference no. 14-125, on the "Open Government" website. I can confirm this information was released online on 24 August 2014.


