FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 3 September 2018, in which you sought access to the number of petrol and diesel cars, vans, buses, trucks, prime movers, taxis and electric (hybrid) vehicles as at December 2017.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance of section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD is required to provide a decision on your access application by 2 October 2018.

Decision on Access

A search of documents was conducted and the relevant business area has confirmed that the information you have requested is available for a legislated fee from Access Canberra (Strategic ICT Projects, Governance and Support). For convenience I have attached the relevant application form for you. Once completed it can be returned to RegoActSystemSupport@act.gov.au

Noting that the information requested is available for purchase, I have decided to refuse to deal with your access application in accordance with section 45 of the Act. Section 45 provides the grounds to refuse to deal with application if the information:

(f) is usually available for purchase.

I am satisfied that the information you seek is available for purchase. Accordingly, I have decided to refuse to deal with this request.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because no documents are to be released.
