



ACT Summary of Cabinet Outcomes Government Week commencing 23 April 2012

As part of the ACT Government's Open Government commitment, this document is a public summary of matters considered by Cabinet. It is not intended to be a detailed set of minutes and does not cover all matters considered by Cabinet. Among matters not covered are materials considered in the formation of the ACT budget, commercial and industrial matters under negotiation, as well as matters that would impact personal privacy, security and the ACT economy. Nothing in this document can be considered a waiver of the Government's executive privilege.

Committees of Cabinet

Meetings of the Budget Committee of Cabinet were held. Treasury officials joined with Ministers to discuss matters of fiscal significance.

A meeting of the Urban Development Committee of Cabinet was also held. Relevant officials joined with Ministers to discuss matters of development and planning significance.

Financial Management (Cost of Living) Amendment Bill 2012

Cabinet agreed the Government position in relation to the Private Member's *Financial Management (Cost of Living) Amendment Bill 2012*, as presented by Mr Brendan Smyth MLA on 22 February 2012. The Government will seek amendments to the Bill, as Tabled in the ACT Legislative Assembly on 2 May 2012.
