Summary of impacts:

- Through a targeted program of land release, the ACT Government aims to ensure the land supply strategy across the residential, commercial, mixed-use, industrial and community sectors aligns with forecast demand and responds to related Government plans and strategies.
- Consistent with the Government's intentions for the city's infrastructure, directions in the planning strategy and housing strategy the land supply strategy contributes to shaping how Canberra grows.
- Land release remains an important source of revenue for the Territory.
- 2020-21 Housing Targets provide dedicated opportunities for affordable home purchase for eligible households and identifies specific sites for new public and community housing.
