I confirm your application (below) was received by Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD). No documents relevant to your request are held by the Directorate.

I have received confirmation from Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD), that they may hold documents relevant to your request, however due to the broad scope of the request, a refusal to deal with the application under section 43(1)(a) of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* will be the most likely outcome. The response from Strategic Compliance and Coordination, Construction and Utilities, CMTEDD is that unfortunately it would be an unreasonable

diversion of Access Canberra resources to find the statistics as building documents over the last 20 years have been stored over multiple electronic databases and hard copy files. There are currently over 100,000 building files in the ACT and to go through every single one of these would be an enormous task to say the least. Additionally, Access Canberra does not issue "demolition orders" as such for unapproved building work. Access Canberra has a policy of engage and educate where they work with the public to either go through the necessary approvals or bring structures into compliance. Under the *Planning and Development Act 2007* ACT Government inspectors have the authority to issue a Controlled Activity Order. These orders can include demolition of unapproved structures, but are not limited to this, and may relate to rectification works and Development Applications being made. Additionally Under the *Construction Occupation (Licensing) Act 2004* the ACT Government inspectors have the authority to issue a Rectification Order if the inspector believes on reasonable grounds that building work was not done in accordance with the Act. This may also involve demolition of structures or other action to rectify non-compliant building work. It would therefore be very difficult to determine how many demolition orders were made as it would require having to go through all Controlled Activity Orders and Rectification Orders.

Please advise if you would like EPSDD to transfer your application (below) to CMTEDD for processing or that you would like to withdraw your application (below) and resubmit a revised application (with specific examples) directly to CMTEDDFOL@act.gov.au.

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 24 August 2020, in which you sought access to:

Specifically, you are seeking:

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.
