Freedom of Information Request – Presence of asbestos – 22 Creswell Street Campbell

I refer to your application under section 14 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1989* (the Act), received by the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 27 October 2017, in which you requested the following:

'Any documents since 2008 held by the Asbestos Response Taskforce that confirm or otherwise the presence of asbestos at 22 Creswell Street, Campbell ACT (Section 17, Block 3, Campbell) (e.g. asbestos air monitoring results and reports following physical inspections or demolition).'

I apologise for the delay in providing you a response and we appreciate your patience throughout the processing of your request.

I am an officer authorised under section 22 of the Act to make a decision in relation to your request.

Decision

The Directorate has identified four documents in its possession that meet the scope of your request, as identified in the schedule attached to this letter.

In this instance, I have decided to partially release all of the identified documents that fall within the scope of your request. Under section 21 of the Act, documents that are partially exempt may be provided to applicants with deletions applied. I have decided to exempt some parts of all scheduled documents under section 41 (Documents relating to Personal privacy).


