### **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST**

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) on 11 January 2019, in which you sought access to information regarding consultations with Unions ACT relating to Contractor Central arrangements.

Specifically, you are seeking: *“Documents related to consultation with Unions ACT on compliance assessments on Industrial Relations obligations for ACT suppliers wishing to be appointed to the Contractor Central arrangements.”*

#### **Authority**

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

#### **Timeframes**

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, CMTEDD was required to provide a decision on your access application by 11 February 2019.

#### **Decision on access**

Searches were completed for relevant documents and numerous documents were identified that fall within the scope of your request. Information that is not relevant to your request has been redacted as out of scope material.

I have included as **Attachment A** to this decision a schedule outlining the relevant documents. This provides a description of the document that falls within the scope of your request and the access decision for that document.

I have decided to grant full access to the relevant document. The document released to you is provided as **Attachment B** to this letter.

#### **Charges**



Item 3 – Contractor Central ACT

Mr Dave Purser, Director-Goods and Services, Procurement and Capital Works in CMTEDD, reported on the proposed move to centralise the ACTPS procurement of contingent labour hire, which is currently carried out by individual directorates. The scheme will be modelled on that operating in NSW involving the pre-qualification of suppliers, overlaid with ACTPS requirements. The advantages include, better reporting, more competitive tendering, and fixed fees. The intention is to go live in March 2017, initially in the area of ITC. Mr Alex White from UnionsACT requested a separate meeting be held with Unions before implementation to discuss the pre-qualification requirements, mandatory contract terms and audit arrangements.

### Background

- As part of a wider reform to improve the procurement for goods and services for the ACT Government, we are changing the way we engage and manage contracted workers.
- ACT Government will leverage off an established NSW Contingent Workforce Scheme, SCM0007, to implement the Contractor Central ACT business solution. This solution will provide an online interface between ACT Government and recruitment agencies to supply quality contracted workers who are not on the ACT Government payroll.
- The use of contract labour is for temporary and urgent engagements, or jobs where there are niche skills that have not been filled through a recruitment process. The project will not affect the current mix of employees to contractors. The ACT Government is focused on the employment of staff, as opposed to contracting, where ever possible.
- Contractor Central will allow for greater visibility of current practises, and allow for improved workforce planning. The scheme has defined costs for conversion of a contractor to permanent placement, including nil fee if through a merit process.
- Information on the NSW Scheme can be found at NSW ProcurePoint, including the scheme conditions and job categories and role types.

### Benefits

- The solution will improve fairness, transparency and compliance by establishing consistent and streamlined processes across all directorates and recruitment agencies in engaging, on/off boarding and managing contracted workers.
- By coordinating contract worker spend through one business solution, ACT Government will be better placed to review its spend and tenure across categories. This visibility will promote greater strategic decision making to identify positions to be made permanent. Presently information on how contract workers are engaged, duration of tenure, and under what conditions they work is only at the business level, and there is limited WhoG reporting.

- Sub-contracting arrangements are not allowed under the scheme, removing the issue of multiple layers of supplier fees.

### **Worker Protection and Pre-qualification**

- This solution is an interface tool only – it will have no impact on award rates or worker rights and entitlements. Suppliers will have to provide a breakdown of contractor’s payment against their award using the system solution.
- The system will provide a way to track that contractors are given the appropriate on-boarding and inductions to do their jobs safely.
- The scheme provides an open arrangement where new suppliers can apply for pre-qualification at any stage.
- As part of pre-qualification, agencies will be required to provide:
  - Financial statements and turn over for the last 3 years;
  - Demonstrated experience supplying contracted workers for each category they wish to supply to;
  - Insurance details (Public Liability, Professional Indemnity, and WorkCover);  
Legal (status, proceedings, insolvency, ICAC, and compliance with OHS&R and Health and Safety).
- There are specific requirements suppliers to the ACT will need to meet that will be in addition to the NSW scheme terms and conditions. These will ensure ACT standards are maintained.
- The scheme allows for auditing and performance management of suppliers, increasing compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements, such as WorkCover, OHS inductions and superannuation. The scheme has a defined dispute management process, and suppliers can be suspended or removed from the scheme if needed. (you might need to find out if this has happened before in NSW in case you’re asked in what circumstance this might happen).

### **If raised**

- The scheme promotes opportunity for participation of Small to Medium Enterprises, and this is measurable and reportable. In NSW has seen an increase in market share for SMEs since the introduction of the scheme.

Action Item	Procurement Capital Works Note
Roles and responsibilities document for contractor labour and a process for escalating issues.	The conversation centred on processes outside of the scope of the procurement and Contractor Central, such as what processes there are for engaging excess officers prior to the decision to contract, and how unions escalate issues with Directorates and centrally. While Contractor Central has the ability to capture feedback on suppliers from hiring managers, the roles and responsibilities for Directorates regarding recruitment and unions' engagement would be better captured as a policy documents. PCW would be happy to contribute to this where required.

## **SCHEDULE 2**

### **STATUTORY DECLARATION**

Statutory Declarations Act 1959 (Cth)

    - (i) the nature of the breach or offence or alleged breach or offence;
    - (ii) any conviction recorded or adverse finding made in respect of the breach or offence;
    - (iii) any penalty or orders imposed by a court, tribunal, board, commission or other entity in respect of the breach or offence and the maximum penalty that could have been imposed under the Prescribed Legislation.
    - (iv) the name of the court, tribunal, board, commission or other entity; the State or Territory in which the proceeding or prosecution is brought; the date on which the proceeding or prosecution was commenced and the number or description assigned to the proceeding or prosecution by the court, tribunal, board, commission or other entity; and

- (v) the name of the person or other legal entity against which the finding or conviction was made or the proceeding or prosecution was initiated.
- e. **“Industrial Instruments”** means an award or agreement, however designated, that:
  - (i) is made under or recognised by an industrial law; or
  - (ii) concerns the relationship of an employer and the employer’s employees.
- f. **“IRE Certificate”** has the same meaning as in the ACT Government’s IRE Strategy;
- g. **“IRE Strategy”** means the ACT Government’s *Compliance with Industrial Relations and Employment Obligations Strategy for ACT Government Capital Works Projects*, as amended from time to time,
- h. **“Prescribed Legislation”** means each of the following:
  - (a) Industrial Instruments applicable to the Tenderer;
  - (b) *Long Service Leave Act 1976* (ACT);
  - (c) *Work Safety Act 2008* (ACT);
  - (d) *Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Act 2009* (ACT);
  - (e) *Workers’ Compensation Act 1951* (ACT);
  - (f) *Workplace Relations Act (1996)* (Cth);
  - (g) *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth);
  - (h) *Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992* (Cth);
  - (i) *Building and Construction industry Improvement Act 2005* (Cth);
  - (j) *Workplace Gender Equality Act 2012* (Cth);
  - (k) *Paid Parental Leave Act 2010* (Cth);
  - (l) *Payroll Tax Act 1987* (ACT);
  - (m) *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* (ACT);
  - (n) any Regulations made under the above Acts;

(o) any laws of the Commonwealth or the Australian Capital Territory which vary or replace the above Acts or Regulations, or any part of them; and

(p) any other Acts or Regulations of the Commonwealth or the Australian Capital Territory, which deal with matters relating to industrial relations, employment and/or workplace safety obligations.

i. **“Prescribed Works or Services”** means works or services that require the exertion of labour by Employees.

j. **“Project”** means Project No **SCM0007** for the provision of Contingent Labour; and

## ***Union Briefing on Contingent Labour***

***4 April 2017***

### ***Talking Points***

#### Protection for workers

- **Contractor Central will not impact staff on ACT Government's payroll (Casual Contractors or temp staff).**
- Contractor Central will not impact any awards or Enterprise Agreements in place and have no impact on work conditions or arrangements between suppliers and their staff.
- The online Vendor Management System maps the award or EA to ensure that these are applied correctly and consistently.
- Sub-contracting is not allowed under the Scheme.
- The onus to uphold work, health and safety requirements will be on suppliers, monitored through Contractor Central.
- Contractor Central will also guide and promote consistent on boarding and off boarding processes for contingent workers
  - Including police and security checks
  - Occupation certificates, WWVP, white cards
  - Site assessment for WHS
  - On boarding and off boarding

#### Enhanced Governance

- Maximum duration of an engagement through the Scheme is for 12 months. If the contractor is extended, this will require a new approval.
- ACT Government Executive will be able to get a consolidated view of their contingent workforce and have greater visibility and information to make staffing decisions regarding positions tenure.
- Contractor Central will enhance ACT Government's transparency, compliance and governance engaging, invoicing, paying and reporting on contingent workers.
- Comensura will be required to do spot audits of suppliers reported activities.

#### No slide but if asked - Prequalification

- **Approximately 29 businesses have pre-qualified to join the Scheme to service ACT Government.**
- **The ACT Government and Comensura are continuing to work with agencies to pre-qualify under the scheme and provide services to directorates.**
- **The Pre-qualification process has consisted of:**
